### QUIET HOUR DURING LENT

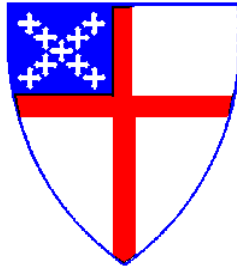
